

The Hereford Wheelers promoted the ninth and closing event of this years Welsh Magic Dragon Series, as a 30 miles time trial on a course comprised of two circuits between Raglan and Abergavenny. The winner, Dave Keene Bristol South CC clocked 1h.06m.22s. 2<sup>nd</sup> Paul Prince Wyre Forest CC 1-08-24, 2nd Derek Rogers Lukracing.net 1-08-37. This gave Keene his sixth win of the series, and with competitors requiring points from five of the nine events to qualify, he has obtained the maximum possible number to win the Series.

In the latest of Abertillery Wheelers weekly 10 miles time trials held on a circuit course between Pontypool and Hafodyrynys, visitor Wayne Dudley set a new course record of 22m.42s.
