

The Abertillery Wheelers 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday 25 miles time trial was held on a course based at Raglan, and using roads to Michell Troy and Abergavenny. In warm but breezy conditions Tony Hudson added another club event win to his fast growing total by clocking 59m.30s. Ian Davies 1-00-59, Ross Phillips 1-01-02, Clinton Evans 1-01-03, Martin latewood 1-02-42, Gareth Chislett, 1-03-35, Dave Evans 1-05-44, Owen Pocock 1-13-16. However, visitors June Edwards and Andrew Butcher stormed around on a tandem in a remarkable 56m.42s. In the Port Talbot 4 up team time trial held on the fast Vale of Neath course Abertillery Wheelers team of Tony Hudson, Ross Phillips, Ian Davies and Martin Latewood were well satisfied with their time of 55m.24s, although the event was won by Port Talbot Wh in 51m.13s., with Cwmcarn PRC a very close second with 51m.17s.

In the latest of Abertillery Wheelers weekly 10 miles time trials on the circuit course between Pontypool and Hafodyrynys Gareth Chislett won with his best ever performance on the course of 24m.16s Clinton Evans 24-40, Dave Evans 25-44, Brian Phillips 26-19, Owen Pocock 30-43
